PANJIM, Feb. 24—"Goa has some of the most beautiful, unspoilt beaches in the world, and I plan to come back and capture this on film for television networks abroad," today said Mr. Robert Tyabji, a member of the team that tele-filmed the recent Carnival celebrations in Goa, on the eve of his departure for Bombay.

Young Mr. Tyabji, who stayed on in Goa to complete the soundtrack of the film, said that he had seen beaches in several parts of the world, but only a few to compare with those in Goa.

He believes that Goa's coastline is a potential major attraction for tourists from all over the world, but feels that they are as yet relatively unknown to the foreign tourist.

Mr. Tyabji said that facilities for tourists, including transport in and out of Goa as well as within, are at present inadequate, but he believes that a greater influx of visitors will result in their improvement.

About the film on Carnival his group was making, Mr. Tyabji said it was shot in colour in selected locations in Goa and would give the world a glimpse of the only Carnival celebrations in Asia.
